### **CONDUCT**

- Report and remove yourself from any real or perceived conflict of interest.
- Do not exploit personal relationships within the National Association for Children of Alcoholics or Faces and Voices of Recovery for personal gain.
- Do not under any circumstances sexually exploit or harass other individuals.
- Do not act in any way that violates the civil, legal or ethical rights of others.
- Work to resist gossip, hearsay and rumors.
- Remember that in the eyes of the general public, we represent children and families affected by parental alcohol and other drug additions as well as those living with long-term recovery and that your actions influence how the community views our organization and its efforts.
